3. The theme of the Challenge Community Services Art Competition 2020 is "Out of this World".
4. The competition opens at 8:00am AEST on Monday, 03 August, 2020. The competition closes at 11:59pm AEST on Friday, 13 November 2020. If entries are received after the closing date, they will not be accepted.
5. Entrants must agree with the Terms and Conditions at the time of entry.
6. Entry is open to people with disability, and children and young people (CYP) in foster care residing in New South Wales. Entrants aged under 18 years must seek parental/carer permission before submitting their entry. By entering, Challenge Community Services assumes parental/carer permission has been sought and the parent/carer agrees with the Terms and Conditions in this document.
7. There are 6 categories available to enter:
 - a. People with Disability
 - i. Ages 0-12
 - ii. Ages 13-18
 - iii. Ages 19-50
 - iv. Ages 50+
 - b. Children and Young People in Foster Care
 - i. Ages 0-12
 - ii. Ages 13-18.

8. Each artist or group of artists must only submit one artwork, to one single category they are eligible for.
9. The entrant must confirm that their submission is their own work and they own the copyright to their design.
10. There are 5 prize divisions for the competition:
 - a. Winner – (\$200.00 AUD prize money per category) as voted by the judge
 - b. Runner up – (\$100.00 AUD prize money per category) as voted by the judge
 - c. Encouragement award – (\$40.00 AUD prize money per category) as voted by the judge
 - d. People’s Choice - (\$150.00 AUD prize money per category) as voted by the public via the Challenge Community Services Facebook page
 - e. Photography award overall (\$60.00 AUD overall prize money) as voted by the judge.

Prize money is provided to the winners by way of a gift card.

11. Challenge Community Services will accept the following mediums:
 - a. Painting on canvas
 - b. Drawing on canvas
 - c. Collage on canvas
 - d. Photograph on canvas or mounted on card.
12. Challenge Community Services will accept artworks with a maximum height or width of 60cm. Please do not submit sculptures or 3D artworks as they cannot be displayed at the exhibition.

15. Entrants must provide the following personal details to allow Challenge Community Services to administer the competition:
 - a. First and last name
 - b. Age at last birthday
 - c. Email address
 - d. Phone number
 - e. Postal address
 - f. Service provider name
 - g. Service provider contact person details
 - h. Category entered
 - i. Title of artwork
 - j. Medium
 - k. Description (optional)
 - l. A high resolution image of the artwork (to be used for online voting).

16. Physical artworks must be clearly labelled with the following details:
 - a. Artist name
 - b. Service provider
 - c. Contact phone number.

17. Names of CYP in foster care will not be published without the expressed permission of a carer/guardian or caseworker. If such permission is provided, Challenge Community Services has sole discretion as to whether the names will be published.

18. Challenge Community Services will elect an external judge who will judge all competition entries.

19. The competition judge will determine the winners, runner up, encouragement and photography awards. The decision of the judge is final.

20. Followers of the Challenge Community Services Facebook page will vote for the People's Choice awards. The artworks with the highest number of votes per category (likes per photo) will be deemed the winners.

21. In the event of a tie between two or more artworks in the People's Choice awards, the judge will determine the winners.

22. An artwork may only be selected as the winner of a single prize category, where a submission is eligible for more than one prize, they will be awarded the prize with the highest value.

23. Challenge Community Services reserves the right to deny any entry that does not comply with the Terms and Conditions, or any entry that is deemed offensive or inappropriate.

People's Choice Awards

25. All accepted entries will be eligible for the People's Choice award which will be voted by the followers of the Challenge Community Services Facebook page and in person at Ray Walsh House, 437 Peel Street Tamworth.
26. Voting opens at 11:00am AEST on Thursday, 3 December 2020. Voting will close at COB on Tuesday, 8 December 2020. Votes received outside this time will not be accepted.
27. Only one vote per category, per person will be accepted.

Exhibition

28. The Challenge Community Services Art Competition 2020 will include a physical exhibition at Ray Walsh House, 437 Peel Street Tamworth.
29. The exhibition will feature up to 250 shortlisted artworks, determined by the space available and size of artworks.
30. The exhibition will be on display from Tuesday 1 December 2020 to Monday 4 January 2021.
31. Following the exhibition, Challenge Community Services will notify entrants to collect their artworks from the nearest Challenge Community Services site. Challenge Community Services is not responsible for any loss or damage of an artwork that is not collected within 60 days of notification.
32. Some entrants may be eligible for return postage if they reside outside of Challenge Community Services regions. This is at the discretion of the Challenge Community Services Marketing Department. If agreed, Challenge Community Services is not responsible for any loss or damage of an artwork in transit.
